

We are approximately 7 kilometers west of the Highway 13 and 21 junction and the drive to the City of Edmonton takes about one hour.

A well developed transportation network including road and rail serves the needs of the region. Other regional attributes include access to training and post secondary education facilities and advanced health care services. 

Healthcare

Residents of Bittern Lake have access to the extensive, modern health care services located in the City of Camrose, only 15 minutes away. Camrose is one of the 40 communities in Alberta with a Primary Care Network (PCN). As well as committing to a cooperative approach to general primary care, the Camrose PCN works with physicians and healthcare providers to develop additional programs and services that meet the needs of the community and its patients.



Education

Bittern Lake is part of the Battle River School Division located in the City of Camrose. There are over a dozen educational institutions in the area, from daycare, to public and private schools, to separate schools and also Francophone options. Camrose is also home to the University of Alberta – Augustana Campus. The campus is close to Camrose's lively downtown core and an extensive trail system for walking, running, bicycling, and cross-country skiing. The City is also home to the Canadian Lutheran Bible Institute.

Post-secondary education is available from Red Deer Community College in Red Deer, Olds College in Olds, and from Edmonton or Calgary-based post-secondary institutions.



Housing



Community Services

Bittern Lake has a variety of local volunteer organizations that organize events in the community. The Village fire services are covered by the County of Camrose. Recreation

The Bittern Lake wild life reserve provides residents with direct access to the wonders of the area and can be accessed by a walking trail, which boasts a multitude of birds and other wildlife. In addition, the Village's proximity to the City of Camrose affords our residents easy access to an almost limitless range of recreational activities. Just some of these opportunities include an outstanding 18-hole golf course with reasonable fees, curling rink, floor curling in the senior centre, swimming pool with hot tub, five screen movie theatre, live theatre, the Jean and Peter Lougheed Performing Arts Centre and much more.
