


Living in The Town of Daysland



ABOUT THE TOWN OF DAYSLAND

Daysland is a small community nestled in the prairie heartland, situated 43 kilometers east of Daysland. The quiet streets are lined with stately trees, and open space areas include a golf course, beautiful parks, and the scenic Crocus Trail walking path. The diverse landscape is characterized by a level to gently undulating topography throughout the region. Our beautiful small Town holds many opportunities including an affordable cost of living, exciting recreational opportunities, business opportunities, friendly people and an enjoyable rural lifestyle.



Daysland is located in the Battle River Alliance for Economic Development (BRAED) region. BRAED is a partnership of communities in East Central Alberta that work cooperatively to address economic development issues from a regional perspective.



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


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Healthcare

Local medical services include Daysland General Hospital, a new 26-bed active treatment hospital offering services in 24-hour emergency, acute care, obstetrics, surgery, respite care, palliative care, and rehabilitation. Daysland is a member of the Flagstaff Family and Community Support Services that offer counseling and the Nights Alive youth program. The Town also has ample facilities for independent senior living including Westside Manors and Providence Place. A full-time ambulance service and a resident dentist round out the local health services. Regional municipalities also offer mental health, family services, rehab, physiotherapy, massage therapy, chiropractors and optometry.



Education

The Battle River Regional School Division #31, headquartered in Camrose, serves Daysland. Daysland School provides a full range of educational programming for Kindergarten to Grade 12 students living in the Town of Daysland and surrounding rural areas. In addition to the regular academic program, numerous extra-curricular opportunities exist, and we encourage all students to participate fully in their grade school experience to make these years as rewarding and enjoyable as possible.

Daysland is close to the Augustana Campus of the University of Alberta, located in Camrose. In addition, the Battle River School Training Foundation is a not-for-profit foundation providing college credit courses to rural Albertans within Flagstaff County and the Battle River Alliance for Economic Development.


