Alberta Tourism Investments in COVID Response

On June 22, Alberta Tourism announced three federally and provincially funded programs designed to address key areas of need. These areas were determined via the Travel Alberta industry COVID-19 impact survey.

The three key areas are:

- \$4 million Alberta Destination Management Organization
 (DMO) COVID-19 Operational Relief Program
- 2. \$4 million Destination Canada Domestic Funding Program
- 3. \$5 million Travel Alberta Cooperative Investment Program
