


ABOUT THE VILLAGE OF LOUGHEED

Lougheed is located in East Central Alberta on Highway 13 near the beautiful Battle River Valley; 200 kilometres southeast of Edmonton and 75 km southwest of Wainwright.

In beautiful settings around Lougheed include agricultural farms and ranches in a variety of sizes. Natural gas and oil activity with associated supply services thrive in the area. Lougheed offers new and used farm machinery and repairs, garden supplies, travel agencies, two water well drilling companies, a car and truck wash plus much more.

We offer many of the amenities one would expect from a large community but can still offer quiet country living that is so attractive.



Lougheed is located in the Battle River Alliance for Economic Development (BRAED) region. BRAED is a partnership of communities in East Central Alberta that work cooperatively to address economic development issues from a regional perspective.



Healthcare

Lougheed is only a 15 minute drive from the hospitals. These Health Centres offer services in acute and continuing care, 24-hour emergency, and X-Ray. The Centre has acute care, long-term care and respite beds. Health unit and home care services are based out of the Sedgewick Health Unit.

Regional municipalities also offer mental health, family services, rehab, massage therapy, chiropractors, optometry and counseling.



Education

Lougheed is part of the Battle River School Division headquartered in the City of Camrose. Central High Sedgewick Public School (K-12) serves as the high school for the community of Lougheed. CHSPS provides a learning environment that is built on a positive sense of belonging, healthy actions and interactions, and smooth transitions between and within our family of schools. We believe in the potential growth of all staff and students.

Lougheed is close to the Augustana Campus of the University of Alberta, located in Camrose. In addition, the Battle River School Training Foundation is a not-for-profit foundation providing college credit courses to rural Albertans within Flagstaff County and the Battle River Alliance for Economic Development.



Housing

The Lougheed housing market offers many attractive options whether you are looking at building a home, buying a home, or checking out rental accommodations.

Heritage

The Iron Creek Museum consist of several heritage building, chock-full of items from founding families as well as the local elevator that houses several displays. The museum is open in the summer only; however, they occasionally host an old-time Christmas concert in the school and light up the wood furnace just like the oldn' days



Community Services

Business services located within the Village of Lougheed include grocery store, bakery, accommodations, restaurants, postal services, insurance services, fitness facilities, welding and drilling services, a liquor store and more.

Emergency services include:

- The Village of Lougheed is serviced by the Lougheed Volunteer Fire Department.
- Ambulance services are provided by the dispatch call from Strathcona County with ambulances from either Killam or Hardisty.
- Police services are provided by the Killam detachment of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police and the County Constable.



Recreation

Recreation is an integral part of life for the residents of Lougheed and there are many varying opportunities based on your interests. During the summer and winter, the Lougheed Field House is the community's hub of activity where people can enjoy various activities and use of a gym. Shoot some hoops, play pickleball, dodgeball, Pound Classes, Yoga, and much more.

In addition to participation in sporting events, Lougheed boasts its own trout pond, located within the village limits, situated a short drive north. Picnic area and outhouses are on-site, with overnight camping also available. Within the village limits beside four (4) baseball diamonds are 15 Full Service Campground Sites, with firepits, picnic table per site.
