

The County of Paintearth No. 18 is a progressive rural municipality in East Central Alberta. The County is proud to boast a strong working relationship with the energy sector. The County boasts an 83 unit wind farm, intense natural resource drilling programs, is home to the Battle River Coal Generating Station, and a major electrical transmission line. In addition, the official High Load Corridor, Highway 36, runs through the middle of the County.



Healthcare

The County is home to Our Lady of the Rosary Hospital, Covenant Health, which is one of two provincial heritage sites located in Castor. Services at the hospital include acute care, continuing care, 24-hour emergency, and more. The County is also home to the Castor Community Health Centre and the Coronation Health Centre along with numerous senior's lodges and housing facilities. Our municipalities also offer mental health, family services, rehab, massage therapy, chiropractors, eye care and other services.



Education

Paintearth County is part of the Clearview Public Schools headquartered in Stettler, and also part of the East Central Alberta Catholic School Division, headquartered in Wainwright. There are numerous educational institutions in the area including daycare, kindergarten, as well as public and private schools. Post-secondary education is available from Red Deer Community College in Red Deer, Olds College in Olds, and from Edmonton or Calgary-based post-secondary institutions. These institutions offer distance education and commuting options. The Paintearth Community Adult Learning Council is available to those that need help with accessing distance education or need a place to study. The council offers programs in English, family literacy, basic adult skills, seniors and the workplace.
