
Living in The Village of Ryley



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
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Healthcare

Our little village is only 15 minutes away from the first class health care facilities offered in the Town of Tofield. The Tofield Health Centre features active treatment and long-term care facilities supported by a professional staff of 140. The Centre offers services in emergency, acute care, continuing care, palliative care, occupational therapy, X-Ray and more. The Vegreville Health Unit is another key player in Tofield, providing public inoculation and a variety of other health-related services.

Mental health, family services, rehab, massage therapy, chiropractors, eye care and other services are also available in Tofield and the surrounding region.



Education

Ryley is part of the Battle River School Division headquartered in Camrose. Children from kindergarten through grade six attend elementary school in Holden, another village just 14 kilometres east of Ryley. The Holden and Ryley students complete their junior and senior high school education at the Ryley School. Ryley is less than an hour drive from institutions in Edmonton such as NAIT, University of Alberta, and Grant MacEwan University. The Beaver County Community Adult Learning Council (CALC) is committed to supporting and promoting lifelong learning to enrich peoples' lives in our communities by providing an assortment of adult-learning opportunities. Continuing education services are also available through Wainwright Adult Learning.



Community Services

Ryley has a variety of local volunteer organizations that organize events in the community and numerous business that well serve the needs of our residents. Emergency services include:

- The volunteer Ryley Fire Department handles a variety of calls such as structure fires, motor vehicle collisions, wild fires, medical assists and dangerous goods.
- The village's police services are provided by the detachment of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police located in the Town of Tofield.



Recreation

Recreation facilities within the village include a first class community centre that holds up to 400 people, and is the site of the Village Market held every first Thursday of every month. Ryley District Museum traces the changes in village and farm life over the decades within the walls of the museum, which is housed in two county schools joined together. Make a splash at the newly renovated indoor Swimming Pool and Fitness Centre, which is administrated by the Beaver Heritage and Agricultural Society. We have excellent shale ball diamonds with an RV Park nearby, an outdoor skating rink, a three sheet curling rink, the new Skate/BMX Park and two playgrounds for the children. At the south end of Main Street, where the CN station once stood, you will find a beautiful park complete with a rubber walking path and a gazebo.
