




Living in The Town of Wainwright




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Healthcare

The Wainwright Health Centre offers services in emergency, acute, continuing, respite and palliative care, surgery, obstetrics, cardiac education and stress testing, rehabilitation, psychiatry, X-Ray, day support and more. In addition, numerous healthcare services throughout the town and the region include medical clinics, chiropractors, dentists, optometrists, physical therapy providers and senior living facilities that can accommodate everyone's needs.



Education

Wainwright is part of the Buffalo Trail Public School Division and the East Central Alberta Catholic School Division, both headquartered in Wainwright as well as the Conseil Scolaire Centre-Nord, which offers French schooling in Wainwright. There are many childcare options available including daycares, dayhomes and pre-kindergarten programs. Continuing education services are available through Wainwright Adult Learning. In addition, Lakeland College in Vermilion is just over a half hour drive away.

Community Services

A diverse range of recreational facilities and places of worship provide families the opportunity to stay active and maintain spiritual well-being. Shops, boutiques and shopping opportunities also abound. (See: visitwainwright.ca/shop-local) In addition, Wainwright also features excellent emergency services:

- The RCMP provides protective services for the entire Municipal District of Wainwright through the Town of Wainwright.
- Wainwright Volunteer Fire Departments consists of dedicated individuals from the community. The committed members of the fire departments are able to respond to incidents twenty-four hours a day from their homes or work.



Recreation

Local recreational facilities include Peace Memorial Park (ball diamonds, tennis courts, playground, basketball practice court) and the Wainwright and District Communiplex (swimming pool, whirlpool, weight training, racquetball/squash courts, dance studio, community theatre). Attached to the Communiplex is the Peace Memorial Multiplex, which houses two NHL-size ice surfaces, an indoor running track, and climbing wall. Other amenities include the Wainwright Curling Club, Wainwright Public Library, Tory Heights ball diamonds, Wainwright Golf Club (18 holes), Rotary Splash Park (19 water features), 16 parks, eight outdoor skating rinks, and a 13 acre soccer park. Dr. Middlemass Park and Picnic Area has 30 serviced sites and the Wainwright Golf Club has 26 serviced sites.

Nearby recreational facilities include Arm Lake Recreational Area (golf, camping, fishing) and the Riverdale Mini-Park (golf, camping, swimming).
